Al Kabbani Brothers Shine at 2025 Saudi Toyota Hill Climb with Ferrari Challenge Machines Taif, June- July-August 2025: The three rounds of the Saudi Toyota Championship Hill Climb concluded with 65 competitors facing challenging mountain twists amid dense fog and hailstones, testing their skills and determination. The event was held at Al-Muhammadiyah slope in Taif under the supervision of the Ministry of Sport and organized by the Saudi Automobile and Motorcycle Federation. Dragon Racing drivers Mamoun Al Kabbani and Faisal Al Kabbani, behind the wheels of a Ferrari 296 Challenge and a Ferrari 488 Challenge Evo, were the stars of the championship.

Delivering a dominant performance, they showcased their speed and talent while quickly

With such commendable performances, both Al Kabbani brothers have firmly asserted




